Only the Civil Ceremony includes an officiant from the County Clerk.
One-Hour and Two-Hour Weddings require you to bring your own officiant.



OPTION 01

\$111

Civil Ceremony



- Appointment required
- Valid California marriage license required
- Arrive 15 minutes early
- 6 guests or fewer
- Ceremony location assigned by City Hall
- Best for intimate elopements

✓ OFFICIANT INCLUDED

Marriage license fee is separate.



OPTION 02

\$1,200

One-Hour Wedding



- Monday–Friday only
- Start times: 9:00 am–3:00 pm
- Mayor's Balcony (~40 seated) or Fourth Floor Gallery (~60 seated)
- Up to 100 guests total
- No food or beverage service
- Acoustic music allowed with advance approval
- Best for a private, elevated ceremony

OPTION 03

\$6,000

Two-Hour Wedding



- Saturdays only
- Start times: 9:00 am–12:00 noon
- Grand Staircase / Rotunda
- Up to 200 guests included
- Includes natural wood folding chairs
- Includes insurance and basic building services
- Best for a grand, full ceremony

✗ OFFICIANT NOT INCLUDED



A California marriage license is required and charged separately. Civil ceremonies are handled through the County Clerk. One-Hour and Two-Hour Weddings are reserved through San Francisco City Hall Events.



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
